

# How to improve your writing skills?




### Reasons for writing

Writing gives you more "thinking time" than you get when you attempt spontaneous conversation.

This allows you more opportunity for **language processing** – that is thinking about the language – whether you are involved in study or activation. Harmer, J. (2007)




 Read regularly. It is a great idea of the different styles of writing and see how to use words appropriately.





Expand your vocabulary. To express yourself clearly, you need a good active vocabulary. That's not just being able to recognise lots of words


 it means actually being able to use them correctly. Do this by learning new words with example sentences, not just word lists.





 Improve your grammar. Always use the appropriate tense and remember to use punctuation.







 You must know how to spell those words correctly. Incorrect spelling chages the meaning of your sentence.
